The **NetZero Energy Transition Association (NETRA)** is a global, member-driven, non-profit industry association incorporated as a non-stock corporation under the Delaware General Corporation Law. NETRA intends to apply for recognition operates as a 501(c)(6) business league under the U.S. Internal Revenue Code and operate to promote and accelerate the global development, commercialization, and scale-up of technologies enabling a net-zero energy transition.

Mission & Objectives

Our mission is to accelerate the commercialization of net-zero technologies across grids, transportation, and industrial sectors, ensuring readiness for mass deployment by 2035.

Strategic Objectives:

1. Influence global policies to create a supportive environment for net zero technologies.
2. Facilitate market development and international partnerships.
3. Foster industry-led innovation and R&D collaborations.
4. Build capacity through specialized training and skill development programs.
5. Provide access to funding and investment opportunities.

Membership Structure & Benefits

NETRA offers a tiered membership model to cater to diverse stakeholders:

- Affiliate Member (\$2,000 USD / year)
- General Member (\$ 10,000 USD / year)
- Patron Member (\$ 25,000 USD / year)
- Leadership Circle Member (\$ 50,000 USD / year)

Special Launch offer:

1. As a special launch offer, NETRA is offering discounts to members signing up for multiple years.
 - 10% discount for 2-year membership and Add an extra 5 % off for every additional year you pre-pay (max 50 % at 10 years).
 - Example: 5-year term → 25 % discount on the 5-year membership dues paid at the signing.
2. Claim a 50 % concession- Available to registered non-profits or start-ups < 5 years old with annual revenue < US \$1 million.

• Knowledge Sharing and Networking:

Through conferences, webinars, and tech tours, NETRA fosters knowledge exchange and international collaboration.

• Access to Capital and Partnerships:

Members gain access to investor networks, funding opportunities, and strategic partnerships.

Terms of Membership

Eligibility and Membership Levels

Membership is open to corporations, organizations, and institutions committed to advancing the global net-zero energy transition. Members may join at one of the four designated levels: Affiliate, General, Patron, or Leadership Circle, each with distinct benefits and privileges as detailed in the official NETRA Membership Brochure.

Membership Term and Dues

Membership shall commence upon receipt of the full annual or multi-year dues payment, as applicable. Membership is valid for the selected term, renewable annually or per the agreed period. NETRA reserves the right to revise dues with prior written notice before renewal.

Membership Rights and Obligations

Members are entitled to access NETRA's programs, events, platforms, and services as per their tier-specific benefits. Members agree to: Actively support NETRA's mission and objectives; Nominate official contact persons for communications; Refrain from using NETRA membership to imply endorsement of products or services without written permission.

Representation and Branding

Members grant NETRA the non-exclusive right to display their logo and name on its website, communications, and reports for acknowledgment purposes. Members may identify themselves publicly as part of NETRA, subject to NETRA's brand use guidelines.

Use of Public Information and Media Content

NETRA may use publicly available information about member companies (such as sustainability reports, product announcements, or website case studies) to develop informative articles, blog posts, or case studies featured in the NETRA knowledge hub. These will always credit the member and be used for educational and outreach purposes.

Additionally, NETRA may capture photographs and video recordings at public or member events and may display these on its website, social media platforms, or other official publications. Participation in NETRA events implies consent for such usage unless otherwise notified in writing in advance.

Termination of Membership

Membership may be terminated by the Member at any time via written notice. NETRA may terminate membership if a Member violates the terms, fails to pay dues, or engages in conduct contrary to the objectives of the Association. No refunds shall be issued upon voluntary withdrawal or termination.

Limitation of Liability

To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law:

- a) NETRA provides its services, content, and participation opportunities "as is" and "as available," without warranties of any kind—express, implied, statutory, or otherwise—including but not limited to warranties of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, or non-infringement.
- b) NETRA does not guarantee specific business outcomes, investment returns, regulatory decisions, or partnership success from participation in any of its councils, events, programs, or knowledge resources. Members remain solely responsible for decisions made based on NETRA outputs or engagements.
- c) In no event shall NETRA, its directors, officers, employees, or authorized representatives be liable to any Member or third party for any indirect, incidental, consequential, exemplary, punitive, or special damages—including but not limited to lost profits, business interruption, loss of goodwill, or reputational harm—arising from or in connection with NETRA membership or participation, even if advised of the possibility of such damages.
- d) NETRA's total cumulative liability, whether in contract, tort (including negligence), or otherwise, for any claim related to membership or services rendered shall not exceed the total membership dues paid by the Member to NETRA in the 12 months preceding the event giving rise to the liability.
- e) NETRA shall not be held liable for any information, materials, or activities shared by Members, speakers, or third parties during events, webinars, meetings, or through the NETRA platform. Each participant is responsible for their own statements and conduct.
